Manufacturers and Models for New Qualified Clean Vehicles Purchased in 2023 or After

If you bought and placed in service a new qualified plug-in electric vehicle (EV) or fuel cell vehicle (FCV) on January 1, 2023 or later and meet certain income limitations, you may be eligible for a <u>clean vehicle tax credit</u> up to \$7,500 under Internal Revenue Code Section 30D.

Qualified Manufacturers of the vehicles listed below have indicated that the vehicles are currently eligible for a credit provided other requirements are met. Check back for additions to this list.

For <u>vehicles purchased in 2022 or before</u>, credit eligibility was determined under different criteria.

North America Final Assembly and MSRP Requirements

Vehicle make/models that appear in the list below do not automatically qualify. They must also

- Have undergone final assembly in North America
- Not exceed a manufacturer suggested retail price (MSRP) of
 - \$80,000 for vans, sport utility vehicles and pickup trucks
 - \$55,000 for other vehicles

To see if a specific vehicle meets the assembly requirements:

- Note the vehicle's Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
- Go to the Department of Energy's page on <u>Electric Vehicles with Final Assembly in North</u>
 America
- Use the VIN Decoder tool under "Specific Assembly Location Based on VIN"

Buyers will need to use the vehicle identification numbers to confirm whether their vehicle qualifies for the credit.
